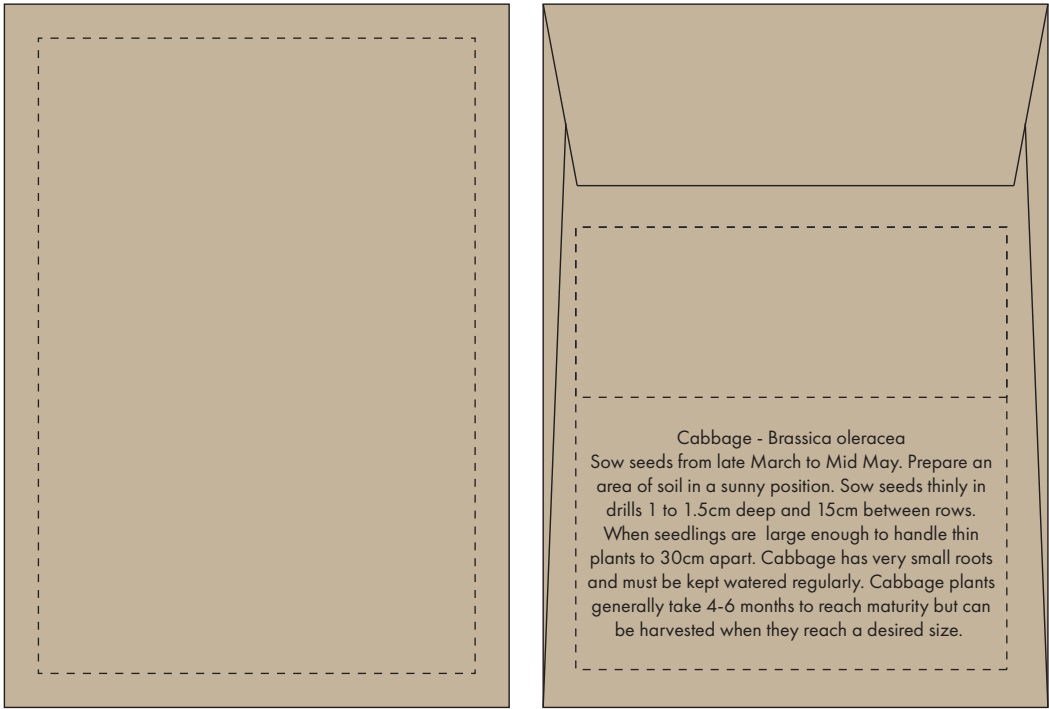

Cabbage - Brassica oleracea

Sow seeds from late March to Mid May. Prepare an area of soil in a sunny position. Sow seeds thinly in drills 1 to 1.5cm deep and 15cm between rows.

When seedlings are large enough to handle thin plants to 30cm apart. Cabbage has very small roots and must be kept watered regularly. Cabbage plants generally take 4-6 months to reach maturity but can be harvested when they reach a desired size.
