



Growing Instructions Sow onion seed indoors between February and April in a seed tray at a depth of Icm. Place in a propagator or seal container inside a plastic bag at a temperature of 10-15°C until after germination which 10-15 C until after germination which usually takes 10-14 days. Once germinated, grow onions on in cool conditions until all risk of frost has passed and they are large enough to plant outdoors at a distance of 10cm (4") apart. Cover with a protective netting or fleece to prevent attack from birds and insects. Water the plants thoroughly after planting.

1 packet Parsley seeds Petroselinum crispum 1 mini plant pot 1 Cocopress® peat-free soil

Growing Instructions Sow indoors all year round or under glass from August to February. Sow seeds in pots on the surface of good quality seed compost and cover with a light sprinkling of compost and place in a warm, light position. Parsley can take a little while to germinate, up to 28 days if the soil is too wet and cold. When seedlings are large enough to handle, thin out to leave only one or two plants per pot. Sow outside from March to July directly in a well prepared seed by the full gue. Sow seeds thinly Sow indoors all year round or under prepared seed bed in full sun. Sow seeds thinly at a depth of Icm in drills 30cm apart. When large enough to handle, thin out the seedlings within each row to 20cm apart.

Growing Instructions
Sow the seeds directly in the place they are to grow between April and September. Cover the seeds with lem of soil or compost and gently firm down the soil and water. When the seedlings have 3 or 4 leaves, thin them out leaving a lem gap between each plant. Germination usually takes only 8-10 days and radish can be harvested roughly! I month after planting.


